### PRE-SCHOOL UNIFORM

#### INTRODUCTION

Rydal Penrhos pupils are expected to arrive at school each day smartly dressed in the correct, regulation school uniform and accessories.

#### SCHOOL BAGS

Each child requires a Rydal Penrhos bag; this should be a school book-bag for Pre-schoolers. Pupils should also have their own rucksack, which they are able to carry, and a school swimming bag.

#### SUMMER / WINTER UNIFORM

Pre-school pupils are not required to wear the summer or winter uniforms. The school encourages Pre-school pupils to wear the gold school polo shirt and black jogging bottoms or shorts every day of the year, alongside the school sweatshirt and coat.

#### HAIR

Hair should not be patterned, shaved (less than grade 2) or dyed an unnatural colour, and should be tied back (with pale blue, gold or grey coloured hair bobbles and clips). Fringes should be kept short to ensure that vision is not affected. Hair should be clean, neat and tidy in appearance with no extreme styles, in keeping with wearing school uniform. Shoulder-length (or longer) hair should be tied back for health and safety reasons.

#### JEWELLERY

Jewellery should be kept to a minimum. Pupils can wear stud earrings only and must be able to remove these themselves for sports activities. No other jewellery items are allowed in school for safety reasons.

#### ADDITIONAL NOTES

Please note that every single item must be named clearly – including shoes, socks, underwear, swimming kit and towels. Please ensure that coats and sweatshirts have sturdy loops so that they can be hung up on the hooks provided outside classrooms and in cloakrooms.

Children in the Pre-school are asked to have Velcro fasteners or buckles on their shoes, but not laces.

Children in Pre-school should have a spare pair of pants, in a small bag, in case of emergencies. This can be left in school until such a time it may be needed.

Children should bring their own supply of tissues and suncream into school daily if needed. For safety reasons, we kindly request that pupils do not bring umbrellas into school.

Nail varnish and false nails are not permitted.

Pre-School pupils should also have a named cycle helmet to be kept in school as they will have access to scooters and tricycles every day.

If your child joins the ballet club there is a school ballet outfit and links can be shared with parents.
