

## Fees 2023–24 (Pre-School)

Pre-School charges / fees are made on a daily basis and charged monthly in advance.

### For children aged 3

Whole day (includes lunch)	From 0800 to 1630	£55
Half day (does not include lunch)	From 0830 to 1200	£28
	or 1300 to 1630	£28
Wrap around care (to include afternoon tea)	1630 to 1800	£10

### For children aged 2

Please note that the number of children at any one time will be limited to eight.

Whole day (includes lunch)	From 0800 to 1630	£58
Half day (does not include lunch)	From 0830 to 1200	£30
	or 1300 to 1630	£30
Wrap around care (to include afternoon tea)	1630 to 1800	£10

- The minimum requirement is for each pupil to attend pre-school for 2 days a week either 2 full days or 4 sessions, 1 session is either a morning or an afternoon.
- Fees are billed for 34 weeks a year / 170 days every week in term time, regardless of any sickness or holidays taken.
- Sessions are booked & confirmed at the start of each academic year. Any changes in set weekly days need to be requested with a terms notice by emailing preschool@rydalpenrhos.com
- Wrap around care is book in the same way as daily session. Change requests can be made with 1 months' notice.
- Additional sessions can be requested at any time in by emailing preschool@rydalpenrhos.com and is agreed subject to availability.
- We reserve the right to charge a fee for any pupil who is collected later than the hours that they have booked on any one day.
- Fees for the second child and subsequent siblings receive a 5% fee reduction.

#### **REGISTRATION AND ACCEPTANCE**

A non-refundable registration fee of £100 is payable on completion of the registration form.

Upon acceptance of the offer of a place, a deposit of £500 is required which is accounted for at the end of the pupil's final term. The deposit becomes non-refundable if, once the offer of a place has been accepted at Rydal Penrhos, the child does not take up the place.

### **PAYMENT AND NOTICE**

All fees are billed six weekly in advance and we request that all fees are settled within the terms stated on the invoice. Additional sessions will be billed retrospectively in month following take up.

Parents must give a terms notice in writing to withdraw a child from the school. Where the required period of notice is not given, fees in lieu of notice will be applicable, as per Section H of our Terms and Conditions.



# Fees 2023–24 (Pre-School)

### **FUNDING:**

Rydal Penrhos School is registered for both Early Education Funding and Childcare for Wales.

What does 30 hours free Childcare mean? The 30 hours is made up of two schemes, Early Education Funding (10 hours) and The Childcare Offer for Wales (20 hours)

## **Early Education Funding**

Children turning three between September and December, are eligible for funding in the Spring and Summer terms at approved non-maintained settings. This includes Rydal Penrhos Pre-School.

Children turning three between January and March, are eligible for one term (Summer) at approved non-maintained settings. This includes Rydal Penrhos Pre-School.

Children turning three between April and August, are **not** eligible for Early Education Funding in any non-maintained settings.

All children turning three between 1 September and 31 August in any given year would, as a rule, start part-time nursery class at a school in the following September. This is funded by the Council at one of its County Borough Schools, but not funded by the Council at independent schools.

### The Childcare Offer for Wales

The current funding available under this scheme is £5 an hour for a max of 20 hours a week, totalling £100 a week max. This is paid weekly and will be deducted against monthly bills.

- Children are eligible for up to 20 hours a week of childcare and up to 30 hours a week during 9 weeks of school holidays.
- Parents must meet certain criteria to be eligible.

- If approved, your child will be eligible in the term after their third birthday.
